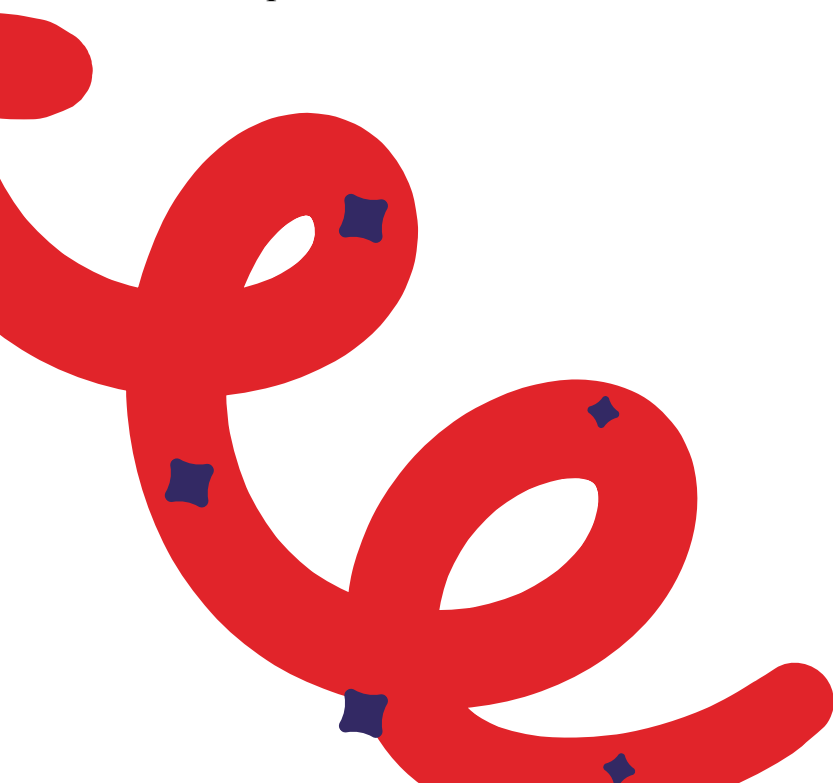

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

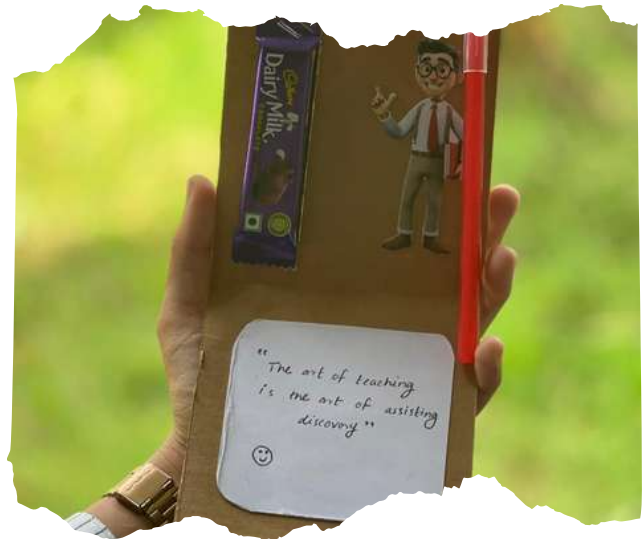
ON 15TH AUGUST 2024

BREAST CANCER AWARENESS RALLY ON 20TH OCTOBER 2024

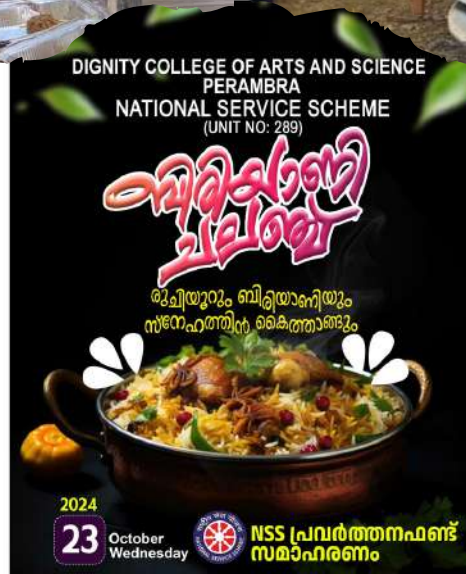
