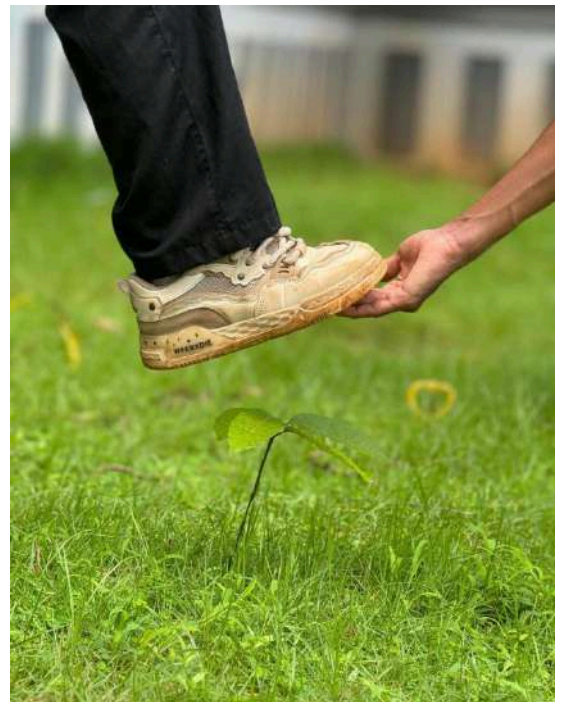
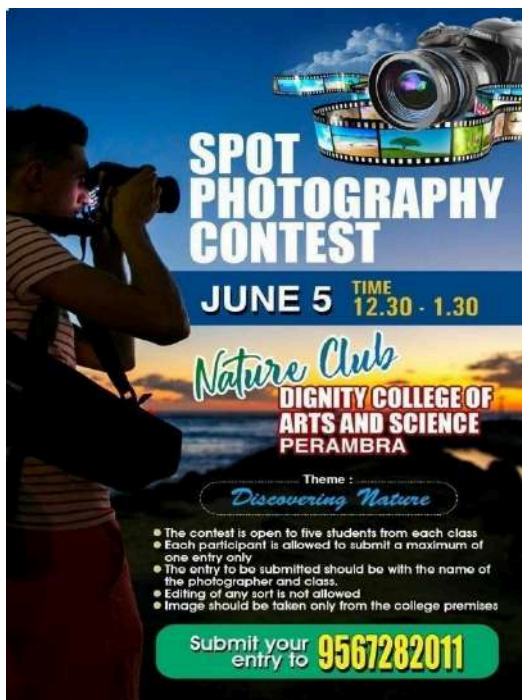

## **Modification and Maintenance of Herbal Garden**

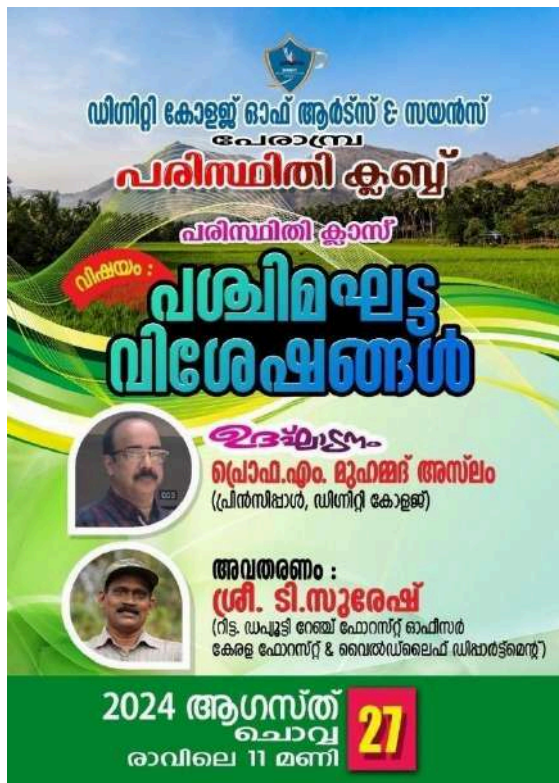
*The medicinal plant garden constructed on the college premises was renovated and maintained with the inclusion of more plants on 29 July 2024.*

## Observance of World Soil Day.

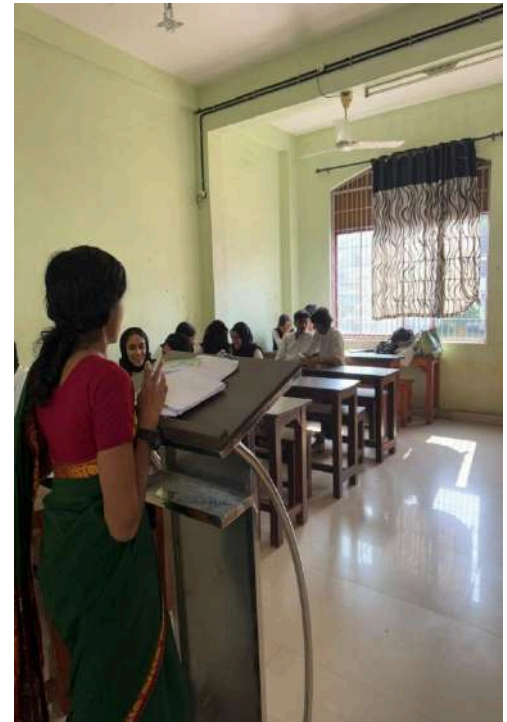
*The natural club members raised awareness about the process of soil transformation, its importance and conservation through an exhibition of different types of soil samples on 5th December 2024. .*

## National Cleanliness Day.

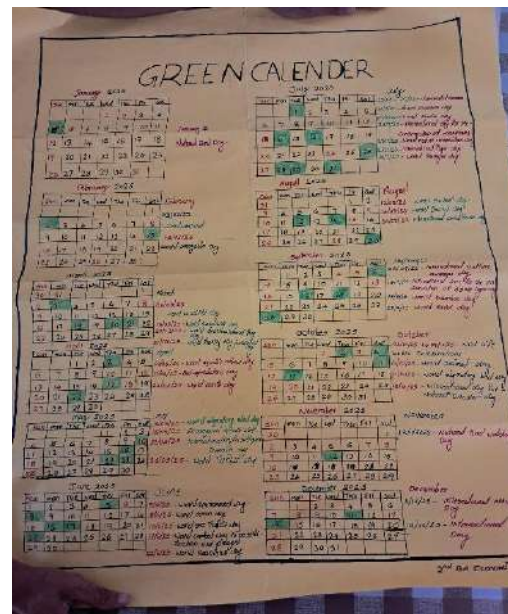
*The campus and its surroundings were cleaned under the leadership of the nature club students as part of National Cleanliness Day on 30th January 2025.*

## Debate on Human Wildlife Conflict

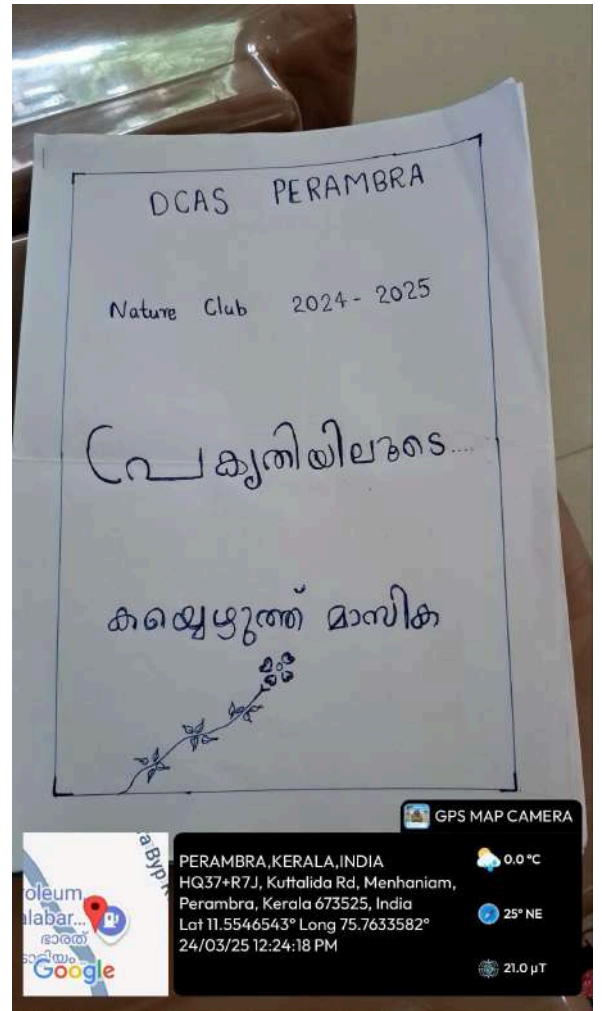
